ACHF Awards \$255,000 to Local Nonprofit Organizations

Grants support community health and wellness programs in Ashland, Talent, & Phoenix

ASHLAND — Ashland Community Health Foundation (ACHF) has invested \$255,000 in eleven local nonprofit organizations that expand or create access to health and wellness programs in Ashland, Talent, and Phoenix. This is the second year that ACHF has supported such programs through its Community Health and Wellness grant awards.

In early 2023, nonprofits were invited to submit grant proposals. After careful review, the ACHF board voted to approve grant awards to the following organizations that stand ready to meet the most pressing community health needs.

- La Clinica for expanded Behavioral Health Services at Ashland High School's school-based health center

- OHRA for increased Resource Navigation Services staff
- Oregon Adaptive Sports for their Moving Mountains Project adaptive ski program at Mt. Ashland
- Rogue Valley Farm to School for the Digging Deeper Partnership in Phoenix-Talent schools and TRAILS outdoor school in Ashland
- Rogue Valley Mentoring for expanding their Mentoring Circles at Talent Middle School
- Southern Oregon Jobs with Justice for the Community Peace Meal program
- Talent Maker City for their Accessibility & Connection Collaboration wheelchair maintenance workshops
- United Rotary Clubs of Southern Oregon to support the Dolly Parton Imagination Library for young children (birth to age 5)
